Timber dray capsizes, Henry Delahey killed

Henry Delahey senior died unexpectedly on 30 September 1851 as the result of an accident at Kings Street in Melbourne.

An inquest was held yesterday at the Kilkenny Inn in Lonsdale-street on the body of Henry Delahey, a labouring man who resided at Saltwater River. The deceased was returning home from town with a dray load of timber, and having arrived at a deep gully at the intersection of King and Lonsdale streets, the dray was unfortunately capsized, and the driver buried under the load. The poor fellow was immediately extricated and carried into the Kilkenny Inn, but it was ascertained that life was quite extinct. Verdict, accidental death.
