FATAL ACCIDENT.

Dr Youl held an inquest to-day, at the Old Lamb Inn, Elizabeth street, on the body of Mary Corcoran, aged 66 years, wife of a farmer living at Broadmeadows, who died on Saturday, from fracture of the ribs, caused by the wheel of a cart, driven by herself, and from which she jumped in anticipation of a collision with a cart belonging to Mr Terry, brewer, passing over her back in Elizabeth street on Monday last. The jury found a verdict of accidental death.
