A man who grew up and spent his early school days in Sunshine in the 1930s, was killed instantly with his wife, when his car was involved in a collision near Wangaratta recently.

Mr Fred Hjorth, a former Lawson St. resident who attended Our Lady's primary school, was one of the original SEC employes on the Kiewa hydro-electric power scheme at Bogong.

Fred, who resided at Mt. Beauty, was well known for his sporting ability. A leading member of the Sandy Creek and Tallangatta football and cricket clubs, he later became a prominent member of the Mt. Beauty Golf Club with his wife, Lal.

Mr and Mrs Hjorth are survived by their son Adrian.
