Fatal accident at Deer Park

Sunshine's second fatal accident for the year occurred last weekend at Deer Park.

Robert Fleming, 66, of Wingate Ave., Ascot Vale, was killed when he was thrown from a car in which he was travelling when it collided head-on with another near the 13-mile post in Ballarat Rd., Deer Park, last Saturday night.

Fleming died in an ambulance when he was being transported to the Footscray and District Hospital.

Fleming was a passenger in a taxi-cab being driven by Leslie Bishop, of Highett Rd., Highett, when it collided with a car being driven by Eleanor Bunning, of Broderick St., Wendouree.

Other passengers in the taxi, which was travelling towards Melbourne, were J. Arnold, of Moonee St., Ascot Vale; and W. Piggot, of Suffolk St., Maidstone.

Both Arnold and Piggot, along with the driver of the other car and a passenger, Ted Gam, of Drummond St., Carlton, were injured and taken to the Footscray Hospital.
