HOLIDAY ACCIDENTS

DEATH IN HOSPITAL.

Sequel to Head-On Collision.

ARARAT, Monday.—Kenneth James McKay, 23 years of age, who resides with his brother, Norman Morrison McKay, at Tainage-street, Sunshine, died in the Ararat Hospital this morning from injuries received in a motor car accident on Saturday evening on the Avoca-Ararat road, about three miles on the Ararat side of Elmhurst.

Deceased, who was a nephew of the late Mr. Hugh McKay, of Sunshine, was spending the week end in the district, and was in a car which was being driven by Keith R. Ross, of Elmhurst, when a head-on collision occurred with another car, driven by John James Bryce, farmer, of Moombooldool, New South Wales, who was journeying to Stawell with his father to see his wife's mother, who had met with an accident.

An inquest was conducted this afternoon by Mr. J. Moore, J.P., deputy coroner. After hearing the evidence, a verdict of accidental death was returned, the deputy coroner stating that no blame was attachable to anybody. Rain was falling heavily at the time of the accident.
