

**THE RAILWAY ACCIDENT AT
BRAYBROOK.**

DEATH OF THE VICTIM.

Mrs. Jane Taylor, a resident of Hotham-street, Footscray, who was received into the Melbourne Hospital on Thursday last, suffering from severe injuries through being knocked down by a railway train at the Braybrook level crossing, died on Saturday night. Her injuries had been of a most serious character, including fractures of the right leg and shock, and as she was 75 years of age little hope had been held out for her recovery.
