ACCIDENTS

BOY FATALLY INJURED

Fatal injuries were received by Raymond John Cameron, 11 years, Woods street, Sunshine, when a truck driven by his father, Raymond Cameron, overturned on Ballarat road, Deer Park, on Saturday afternoon last. Mrs. Janet Cameron and their two sons, Raymond John and William, aged 8 years, were passengers in the truck. The boys were taken to the Children's Hospital, where Raymond was admitted with a fractured skull, and died soon afterwards, and William was treated for an arm injury. At the Royal Melbourne Hospital Mr. Cameron was treated for lacerations and Mrs. Cameron admitted with head injuries and facial lacerations.
