**Young Married Man
Tragically Killed**

A YOUNG Sunshine man was killed near Wangaratta early last Saturday morning when a tanker in which he was travelling was struck by another vehicle.

It is believed that the man, Roderick Duncan Bish, 30 years, of 14 Benjamin Street, was sleeping in the cabin of the tanker which was parked on the roadside.

The deceased, who is the son of Mr. and Mrs. T. Bish of Morris Street, was a returned soldier.

He leaves his wife and a son to mourn his tragic passing.

The funeral took place to Footscray Cemetery. Rev. F. Sadler conducted services at the chapel of Nelson Bros. and at the graveside.
