

## MAN DROPS DEAD AT WORK.

Mr. James Flinn, employed as an inspector in the engineering department at the harvester works, collapsed and died in the factory about 3.50 p.m. on Wednesday. No one seems to have noticed his fall, and he was discovered by Leslie Royce Berryman, another employee. Dr. Simpson was at once called, but could only pronounce life extinct. Mounted Constable Shields conveyed the body to the morgue where the usual inquiry will be held.

Mr. Flinn, who was aged 65 years, came with his wife and family of nine from Scotland about six years ago and started work at McKay's in 1923. Since that date several members of the family, finding the climate did not agree with them have returned to Scotland. Much sympathy is felt for Mrs. Flinn who lives with the remaining members of the family, in Forrest street, Sunshine.

Interment took place at Footscray cemetery on Friday afternoon.
