At about 5.10 p.m. on Monday evening last, the Deer Park special worker's train collided with a truck at the Anderson Rd-Fraser Street crossing. As a result of the accident, Ivo McDougall, 10 years, of Rockbank Road, Sydenham, received injuries from which he died at the Children's Hospital the following day. The driver of the truck was the boy's father, Colin McDougall, 46 years, who was treated at the Prince Henry Hospital for head injuries.

There have been several accidents at this crossing, and it has no wig-wag to warn people of the approach of any train—though it is fairly open and has a clear approach. About 18 years ago, ex-Cr. J. R. Robinson was seriously injured whilst driving his car across the crossing.
