### **In memory of Annette**

Next Saturday afternoon a crowd of more than 300 is expected to attend a ceremony to be held in the gardens of the Footscray and District Hospital.

The ceremony is being held to officially hand over to the hospital a bed which is being dedicated to the memory of nine-year-old Annette Elizabeth Freiburg, who was killed in a traffic accident last November.

The bed, which cost £500, is being presented to the hospital by the members of the hospital's youth group, the Jays.

Annette was a member of the Jays, and was president of group seven at the time of her death.

#### ● **Speaker**

Representatives of other organisations, of which Annette was a member, will attend. These organisations include the Maidstone State School, the third Maidstone Brownie Pack and the Maidstone Church of Christ Sunday School.

The amount of £500 for payment of the bed was raised by the Jays in less than 12 months. A great number of these Jays are between eight and nine years old.

Guest speaker at the ceremony will be Mrs. Gration of the Lady Nell Seeing Eye dog school in Malvern.
