

KILLED WHILE CRANKING LORRY

While he was trying to crank a heavy transport lorry, which had been left in gear, G. Taylor, aged 23 years, of Station place, Sunshine, a driver employed by Messrs. O. Gilpin Ltd., of Belsou street, East Malvern, was fatally injured yesterday afternoon, when the lorry ran forward and crushed him against another lorry a few yards away in the warehouse yard.

Motor-cyclist Injured in Collision

William Carruthers, aged 30 years, of Gleahuntly road, Caulfield, was admitted to the Alfred Hospital at 2.30 p.m. yesterday following a collision between his motor-cycle and a car at the intersection of Burke and Malvern roads, Gardiner. He was suffering from a lacerated face and concussion.

Cable Tram and Truck Collide

Cable tram traffic was delayed for 25 minutes in Nicholson street yesterday morning following a collision between a tram and a motor-truck at the intersection of Victoria parade and Nicholson street, Fitzroy, when the dummy of the tram was forced from the rails and the grip broken. Two passengers on the dummy of the tram, which was travelling north in Nicholson street at the time of the accident, escaped serious injury. One man was treated later for minor abrasions, and another man who was seated next to him escaped unharmed. The dummy was badly damaged.
