MAN SAW NEW BABY - KILLED ON WAY HOME

Stefan Kreitner, 23 years, of 6 Hammond St., Sunshine was killed on Monday night after leaving Sunshine Community Hospital where he was seeing his wife with her new-born baby.

The accident occurred in Anderson Rd. near Ballarat Rd. Kreitner was thrown some distance into grass at the roadside and it is believed that death was instantaneous.

His companion, Mrs. Gertrud Grzesik, a friend of the family, was also struck and slightly injured. There is no made footpath in this section of Anderson Rd.

Driver of the car involved was Emanuel Xuereb, 5 Marsden Cr., St. Albans.
