

**LEVEL CROSSING ACCIDENT.**

**Driver Dies from Injuries.**

James Brennan, aged 26 years, a driver, who was run over by a train at a railway crossing between Diggers Rest and St Albans on Tuesday night, died from his injuries at the Melbourne Hospital yesterday.

Brennan was on horseback, and was leading two other horses. According to an eye-witness he attempted to cross the line in front of the train when one of the horses, apparently frightened, flinched. Before Brennan could get clear of the line the engine struck him. The horse he was riding was killed, and Brennan had one of his feet severed.
