

LOCAL RESIDENT KILLED

While crossing Ballarat Road near Powell's Hotel, West Footscray on Thursday evening, Robert Gordon Hislop, about 50 years, was knocked down by a car and killed. The body was taken to the Morgue and was identified by Mr J. Doyle, who had lodged with Hislop at Blair Athol Coffee Palace, Sunshine. For the past twelve years Hislop had been living at Blair Athol and was a popular member of the Sunshine sub-branch of the R.S.S.I.L.A., and was also formerly a member of the local Anglers' Club. He came originally from Stawell, and has been employed recently at the Ammunition works, Maribyrnong. Prior to that he was employed at McKay's Harvester Works.
