

ACCIDENTS.

Thrown out of a jinker when it collided with a motor car on Raleigh-road Maribyrnong, on Tuesday Anthony Rogers, 65 years, living in M Pherson-street Footscray, suffered severe injuries. Rogers was conveyed to the Melbourne Hospital by Constable Sutton and admitted to the institution suffering from cerebral irritation, lacerations to the scalp and several fractured ribs.

Albert Bennett, 23 years, of 71 Francis street, Ascot Vale, an engineer, in the employ of the Riversdale Quarrying Co; Braybrook, had his leg caught in a cog-wheel of the stone-crusher on Tuesday and before the machinery could be stopped the limb was fearfully mangled.
