

Station Master Killed in Tragic Accident

Mr. Albert George Brown, 58 yrs., stationmaster at Sunshine, was run over by a train and killed at West Footscray on Monday evening. He lived at Warleigh Rd., Footscray, and it is presumed that he crossed the line to reach his home. A mangled bicycle was alongside the track.

Deceased was a very popular official, being courteous and helpful at all times and popular with his staff, and the deepest sympathy is extended to his widow and family.

The funeral, which was largely attended, took place on Wednesday to the Footscray Cemetery. His workmates and members of the R.S.S.A.I. L.A., numbering 200, marched before the hearse to the graveside, where impressive services were held. Nelson Bros. were the funeral directors.
