## **WORKMAN'S FATAL MISTAKE**

---

On Monday last, the Australian Reinforced Concrete Works at Sunshine, Harold Edward Harris, an employee of the firm, accidentally grasped an electric power wire whilst working on a ladder and was thrown 15 feet to the ground. He was taken to the Royal Melbourne Hospital suffering from head injuries and died soon after admission. He was 29 years of age and leaves a widow and a young daughter to mourn their loss. His parents reside at Eldridge Street, Footscray. The funeral took place at the Footscray cemetery on Tuesday last, the arrangements being in the hands of Walter A. Warne, undertakers, of 291 Barkly Street, Footscray.
