

Unusual Accident Cause of Man's Death

On Tuesday evening Mr William Henry Wanders, of Burke Street, Braybrook, was exercising a number of dogs, when one of them ran between his legs and upset him, causing him to fall on his head on a stone. Mr Wanders was taken to his home and died at 9 o'clock the same night.

Deceased, who was 55 years of age, was a highly respected resident of Braybrook, where he had taken an interest in all public and sporting matters. The funeral took place on Wednesday to the Footscray cemetery, Nelson Bros. having charge of the arrangements. Deceased leaves a widow and seven children—Robert, Martha (Mrs G. Robinson), Reg., Mick, William, Lottie (Mrs A. Gray), Ada and Carrie.
