

2 men die on roads

Two men were killed in road accidents yesterday.

Herbert Day, widower, of Park View ave., Greensborough, was killed when his car crashed into the side of a rock cutting near the 32-mile post on Geelong rd.

Charles Bailey, about 40, of Miller st., Braybrook, was fatally injured when his car and another car collided at the corner of Churchill and Nelson sts., Braybrook.

His wife, Lillian Bailey, was admitted to Footscray Hospital with a fractured leg, and their children, Beverley, 15, and Donald, 12, were treated for cuts and abrasions.
