

AUSTRALIAN JOCKEY KILLED

Ray Hibbs, an Australian jockey, died at Calcutta on March 22 from injuries received in a hurdle race on March 20. After three furlongs had been covered the Australian horse Sunciad failed to rise at a hurdle, throwing Hibbs, who was trampled on by the horses following.

Hibbs was brought to Calcutta for his first season here by Jack Higgins, an Australian and a stipendiary steward.

The body of Hibbs was cremated this afternoon, and his ashes will be sent to Australia.

Hibbs was brought from Australia in 1936 by the Royal Calcutta Turf Club. He was married only recently.
