An accident occurred at the Monsanto Chemical Works on Feb. 2, and injuries sustained by Desmond Farroll, 18 years, residing at St. Kilda, and formerly of Yallourn, proved fatal. He was working on the phenol plant, when he was accidentally splashed with phenol on the face and head. He died on the way to Dr. Guthrie's clinic at Footscray.
