The man has been identified as George Gallagher, 83 years, a shepherd, of St. Albans.

Police think the old man overbalanced and fell into the quarry when returning home from Coronation night celebrations at Footscray on

celebrations at Footscray on Tuesday night.

Deep gashes about the knee and head at first suggested suspicious circumstances, but no action can be taken until the body is examined today by the Government pathologist.

The old man lived in a single-roomed shanty made of corrugated iron about 200 yards from the quarry's edge and about half a mile from St. Albans station.
