Deer Park Man Killed on Road

Fate struck a cruel blow on Friday night last to Deer Park's oldest resident, Mr. George L. Morison, who was in his 92nd year.

Mr. Morison lived with his daughter, Mrs. A. Quinlan, in Hyde Street. It is understood Mrs. Quinlan went to Melbourne that day to see friends going to Sydney. She told her father she would be home about 8 p.m.

While waiting for her to come home, Mr. Morison went out and was apparently crossing Station Road, where PMG workmen are excavating. A number of red warning lights were nearby. Mr. Morison was struck by a car going towards Ballarat Road.

Mr. Morison, one of nature's gentlemen, looked set for the century, but tragedy ended his great and honourable innings.

The funeral took place to Fawcner cemetery. To his sorrowing family the deepest sympathy is extended by the whole community.
